## GreenMobility sets new record in number of trips in Copenhagen

January became a new record month for the electric car-sharing company GreenMobility, as nearly 63,000 trips were taken in the company's cars in Copenhagen – the highest number of trips since the company started in 2016.

"January is traditionally not our busiest time, so it's pleasing that we're already setting records in the first month of the year, and we expect the number to increase further in the coming months as we expand the fleet to 1,000 cars in the Danish capital," says Kasper Gjedsted, CEO of GreenMobility.

Around the turn of the year, GreenMobility introduced an additional 50 Polestar cars, which has been very positively received by the large Copenhagen customer base, where in January 2024 there was also an increase in the number of new customers in Copenhagen by 44% compared to January 2023.

"We have already seen a great demand for our Polestar cars, both from existing and brand new customers, who have become interested in the car-sharing concept and at the same time desire a longer range and greater comfort," concludes Kasper Gjedsted.
