

Transactions in connection with share buy-back program

Company Announcement

COPENHAGEN, Denmark; July 11, 2022 – [Genmab A/S](#) (Nasdaq: **GMAB).** On June 17, 2022 Genmab announced the initiation of a share buy-back program to mitigate dilution from warrant exercises and to honor our commitments under our Restricted Stock Units program.

The share buy-back program is expected to be completed no later than August 31, 2022 and comprises up to 370,000 shares.

The following transactions were executed under the program from July 4, 2022 to July 8, 2022:

Following these transactions, Genmab holds 380,883 shares as treasury shares, corresponding to 0.58% of the total share capital and voting rights.

The share buy-back program is undertaken in accordance with Regulation (EU) No. 596/2014 ('MAR') and the Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2016/1052, also referred to as the "Safe Harbour Regulation."
