





KOL Call on Positive Topline Results from Phase 2 Trial: Tesomet for the Treatment of Hypothalamic Obesity

Hosted by Saniona (STO: SANION)

The event will feature a presentation by Key Opinion Leader and Principal Investigator on the Phase 2 Trial of Tesomet in Hypothalamic Obesity **Professor Ulla Feldt-Rasmussen**, **M.D. DMSc (Department of medical Endocrinology and Metabolism, Rigshospitalet Copenhagen University Hospital)** who will discuss the current treatment landscape and unmet medical need for patients with Hypothalamic Obesity (HO). Dr. Feldt-Rasmussen will also review the topline results from Saniona's recently announced Phase 2 trial for Tesomet for the treatment of patients with HO and how these results may lead to a potential new treatment option for these patients. Dr. Feldt-Rasmussen will be available to answer questions at the conclusion of the call.

Saniona's management team will also provide an overview of the rationale and strategy for the development of Tesomet for patients with HO. The Company's recently announced positive Phase 2 results showed that Tesomet was safe and well tolerated in HO patients and that treatment led to statistically significant improvements in key efficacy endpoints including changes in body weight, waist circumference and glycemic control compared to placebo.

Ulla Feldt-Rasmussen, MD Professor Ulla Feldt-Rasmussen, MD, DMSc

Feldt-Rasmussen, MD Ulla is Chief Physician of the Endocrine Division, Department of Medicine at National University Hospital in Copenhagen. Dr. Feldt-Rasmussen also practices at Rigshospitalet. Additionally, Dr. Feldt-Rasmussen is a professor at University of Copenhagen and an adjungated professor at University of Messina, Italy. Previously, Dr. Feldt-Rasmussen was a consultant and senior lecturer for the Department of Medical Internal Medicine at the Gentofte Hospital, Copenhagen University. She was also a senior lecturer and scientist for the Department of Medical Endocrinology, Frederiksberg Hospital, Copenhagen University.

Dr. Feldt-Rasmussen has been involved in research related laboratory work with supervision and tutor function for technicians and young research associates at both pre- and postgraduate level since 1975. The research areas have mainly been related to clinical and experimental projects concerning the thyroid gland, neuroendocrinology and autoimmunity. Dr. Feldt-Rasmussen has also been a regular reviewer for many international scientific journals at approximately 5 reviews per month, editor of many international journals and textbooks and has also published around 450 scientific papers and >1200 abstracts and oral communications. Dr. Feldt-Rasmussen has memberships in multiple scientific associations, including the Endocrine Society, The American Thyroid Association and European Society for Endocrinology, and serves on several committees in these organizations. She is also a recipient of multiple awards, including Hagedorn's Award, the European Thyroid Association Excellent Organization Achievement, the Haines Lecturer's Award, Mayo Clinic, Rochester, US, The Pinchera Research Prize, European Thyroid Association and the Bror-Axel Lamberg Prize, Finnish Endocrine Society.
