Share Buyback Program

On [26 February 2026](#), Bekaert announced the start of the next tranche of its share buyback program, for a total maximum consideration of up to € 75 million. As announced previously, the purpose of the Program is to cancel all shares repurchased.

Bekaert announces today that during the period from 10 September 2026 to 16 September 2026, Kepler Cheuvreux SA on behalf of Bekaert has bought 59 000 shares.
