

## New prestigious contract for ZetaDisplay in Norway

Malmö - ZetaDisplay AB (Nasdaq Stockholm:ZETA) announces that ProntoTV, the Norwegian subsidiary, has won a tender for a new contract with Ruter AS, the public transportation company for Oslo and Akershus. The tenure of the contract is ten years and starts right away. The contract value is estimated at 20 MNOK (2 M€).
