### Global findings

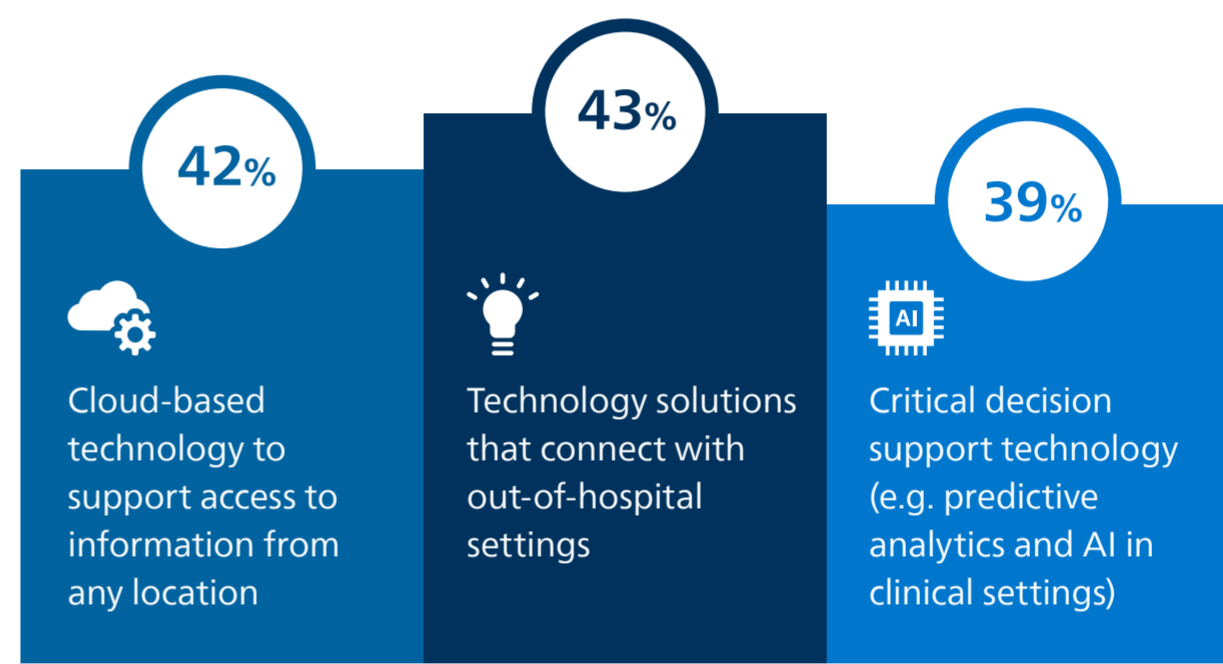
Healthcare leaders and younger healthcare professionals are aligned in their vision to innovate new models of care delivery that meet patients where they are

This year, the report explores how they view the role of new care delivery models, which integrate in-person and virtual care within and beyond hospital walls.

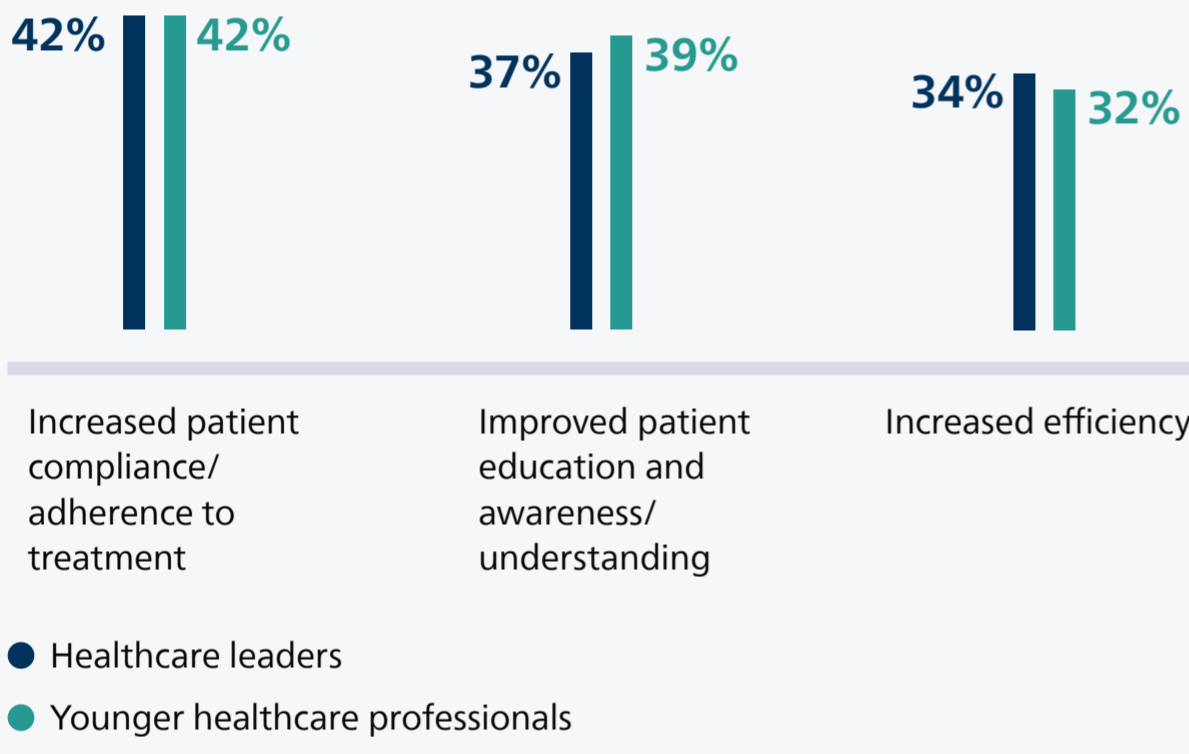
### Healthcare leaders are innovating to mitigate the impact of staff shortages

Healthcare leaders and younger healthcare professionals agree on the benefits of new ways to deliver care, besides patient outcomes



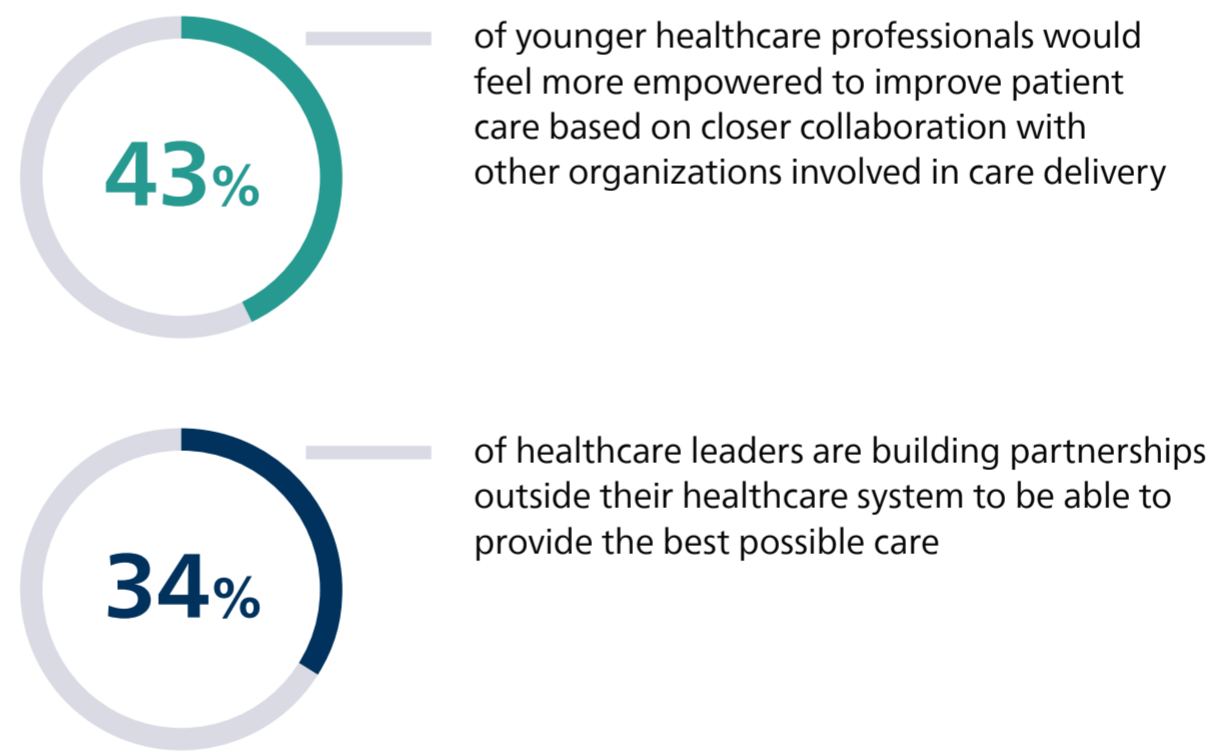
### Leaders and younger professionals see many benefits of new care delivery

For both groups, building partnerships across care settings is one of the top ways to improve patient care and, ultimately, outcomes.

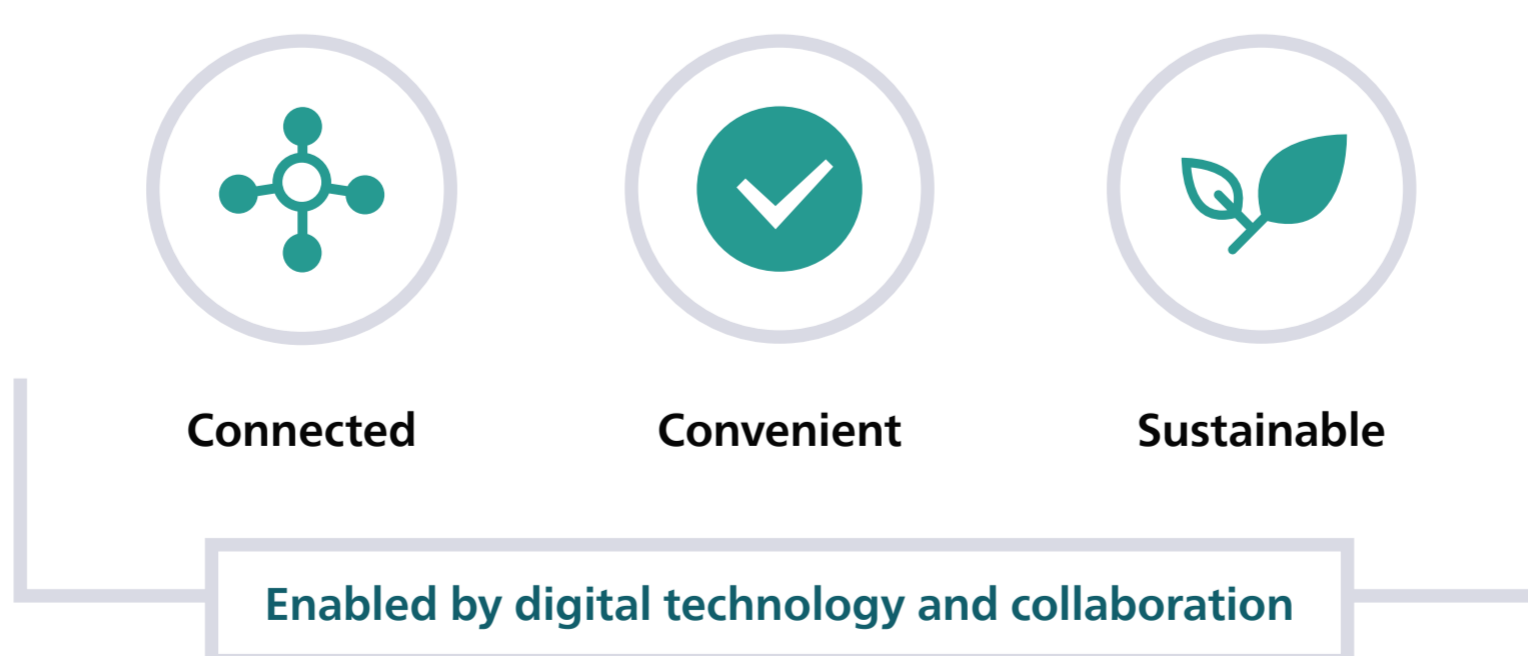
