NOTES TO THE FORM OF PROXY*

- As a member of the Company, you are entitled to appoint a proxy to exercise all or any of your rights to attend, speak and vote at the Meeting. You can only appoint a proxy using the procedures set out in these notes and more fully described in the Company's articles of association. A proxy need not be a member of the Company but must attend the Meeting to represent you. A proxy may demand, or join in demanding, a poll. A proxy need not be a member of the Company.
- 2 Appointment of a proxy does not preclude you from attending the Meeting and voting in person. If you have appointed a proxy and attend the Meeting in person, your proxy appointment will automatically be terminated.
- 3 To appoint as your proxy a person other than the Chairman of the Meeting, insert their full name where indicated. If you sign and return this proxy form with no other name inserted, the Chairman of the Meeting will be deemed to be your proxy. Where you appoint as your proxy someone other than the Chairman, you are responsible for ensuring that they attend the Meeting and are aware of your voting intentions.

- 6 In the case of a corporation this proxy must be given under its common seal or be signed on its behalf by an attorney or officer duly authorised.


