Ipsen Statement on Lanreotide Generic Supply Challenges

PARIS, FRANCE, 9 January 2026 - Ipsen (Euronext: IPN; ADR: IPSEY) is aware of recent updates on the potential challenges with regards to the manufacturing and availability of generic Lanreotide in several markets. Ipsen stands ready to supply Somatuline (60mg, 90mg, 120mg) at the volumes required to address patient needs in all markets where we are present. We are actively monitoring the situation and working with healthcare stakeholders to maintain continuity of care. Ensuring patient access to treatment is our highest priority. We will assess any potential positive impact to Somatuline sales and plan to issue our guidance for 2026 with the 2025 full year results on February 12th as usual.
