Each user can test their control of the aircraft by going through the center of the virtual targets on each of the five increasingly difficult routes, and take part in a "buddy-buddy" in-flight refueling mission.

Fully compatible with Oculus Rift virtual reality headsets, "Aboard the Rafale" allows those equipped with the headsets to benefit from an even more immersive 360° experience!
