Update Annual General Meeting ABN AMRO: withdrawal agenda item discharge 2020

The Annual General Meeting will be held on Wednesday 21 April 2021 at 14:00 CET.

On 19 April 2021, ABN AMRO announced it has accepted a settlement offer from the Dutch Public Prosecution Service in connection with the previously announced AML investigation. Due to the short time frame, the announcement on the settlement could not be taken into account by share- and depositary receipt holders when voting at the Annual General Meeting. Most share- and depositary receipt holders have already issued their voting instructions before the disclosure on Monday 19 April 2021.

ABN AMRO has therefore decided to withdraw the agenda item relating to the discharge of the Executive Board members and Supervisory Board members for 2020 at the Annual General Meeting to be held tomorrow .

Deadline to submit questions extended

In addition, ABN AMRO has extended the possibility to submit questions in view of the announcement of 19 April 2021. Shareholders and depositary receipt holders now have the opportunity to submit questions until 18:00 CET today via email address generalmeeting@nl.abnamro.com.
