# **VINCI Autoroutes and VINCI Airports traffic in May 2024**

### I- Change in VINCI Autoroutes' intercity networks traffic

Traffic across all vehicle categories – almost stable in May – brings back its contraction since the start of the year to -1.2%. This is mainly due to the blockades underwent in the first quarter 2024.
