Corbion's 10th Year Supporting Harvesters to Be Biggest Ever

Employees from company's Lenexa and Grandview locations will pack more than 11,000 boxes of holiday meals to feed KC Metro families at Thanksgiving.

Harvesters—The Community Food Network will host more than 100 Corbion employees on Thursday, Oct. 17, when they will pack the ingredients of a traditional holiday meal for thousands of families across the metro area.

It will be the tenth consecutive year that the company and its area employees have given their time, money and effort to make a difference for their neighbors in need.
