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MANAGEMENT REPORT

First quarter of 2021:

- Total revenue amounted to EUR 99.7 million, an increase by 8.2 per cent over the revenue of EUR 92.1 million for the first quarter of 2020.
- EBITDA was EUR 34.8 million, an increase by 6.1 per cent over EBITDA of EUR 32.8 million a year ago.
- Adjusted EBITDA (excluding non-recurring items) amounted to EUR 34 million and was 2.9 per cent higher than adjusted EBITDA of EUR 33 million during the first three months of 2020.
- Profit for the period was EUR 13.1 million, up by 4.4 per cent over the profit of EUR 12.5 million a year ago.
- Free cash flow amounted to EUR 22.4 million and was 3.8 per cent lower than for the first quarter of 2020 when it amounted to 23.3 million.

Management comment:

During the first three months of 2021 we continued to operate under second COVID-19 quarantine imposed in Lithuania since November 2020 with our retail outlets partially closed and providing only vital services that could not be offered online. Online sale and remote customer care became extremely important during the pandemic. Closed shops effected sale of mobile devises and cross-border travelling restrictions have a negative impact on revenue from roaming services.

Majority of the Company's employees continue to work from home nevertheless we are preparing for the post-pandemic way of working by introducing the workcation – a possibility to work from any EU country up to one month per year.

The Bank of Lithuania forecasts that the country's GDP during 2021 will increase by 2.9 per cent and during 2022 – by 5.1 per cent, while inflation in 2021 will amount to 1.6 per cent and in 2022 – to 1.9 per cent.

The pandemic revealed the importance of connectivity quality and speed. Our continuous investments into upgrade and expansion of both fixed and mobile networks reflects in growing number of customers and the highest average speed of mobile Internet in the country – 93.5 Mbps. In response to increased demand for IT services and solutions we expanded and modernised one of our data centre in Vilnius. EUR 2 million was allocated for this project.

Also we have started a strategic project to upgrade our mobile network with Ericsson equipment throughout Lithuania. About 2,000 base stations will be installed over the next three years, making Telia Lietuva network more sustainable, secure and ready for commercial 5G deployment in the future. This will be one of the biggest investment projects ever.

In February, we've launched eSIM services using the most advance VoLTE technology. We kicked-off with Samsung smartphones and watches, but soon eSIM service will be available with devices of other vendors.

By the end of March we already had 80 thousand of households appreciating benefits of unique on the market converged service offer, Telia1. Over the last twelve months:

- number of mobile service subscriptions increase by 2.7 per cent up to 1,385,
- number of IPTV users grew by 2.8 per cent up to 253 thousand,
- number of FTTH Internet customers was up by 1.5 per cent up to 299 thousand.

Intake of new customers in combination with the persisting demand for quality connectivity and content as well as IT solutions drives revenue up. Compared with first quarter of 2020 over the year:

- revenue from IT services surged by 26.5 per cent,
- revenue from TV services grew by 11.6 per cent,
- revenue from broadband Internet services increased by 8.7 per cent,
- revenue from billed mobile communication services went up by 5.2 per cent.

Higher revenue and control of operating expenses resulted in higher earnings in 2021 that a year ago. Also, during the first quarter of 2021 we sold our office building in Kaunas and recorded a EUR 1.2 million gain from this sale.

We remain committed to our sustainability agenda. Together with the colleagues from Estonia we are the first in Telia Company Group to reached parity of male and female employed and equal number of male and female managers. Our efforts were recognised during National Responsible Business Awards – Telia Lietuva was named as the Best Employer in 2020 among the large corporations. We are also number one operator in Lithuania according to Sustainable Brand Index rating. As a proof, in March we offered refurbished phones – used but tested smartphones for affordable price.

The Company's Board proposed to the Annual General Meeting of Shareholders that will be held on 27 April 2021 to allocate a record amount of EUR 58.3 million for payment of dividend for the year 2020 (EUR 0.10 dividend per share).

REVENUE

Continuous growth in revenue from mobile communication, broadband Internet, TV and IT services fully offset decline from legacy services – fixed voice telephony and fixed data communication. Travel restrictions due to COVID-19 pandemic have a further negative effect on revenue from roaming services, while equipment is on high demand.

Share of revenue from fixed and mobile communication services amounted to 45.7 and 32.3 per cent, respectively, from the **total revenue** for January-March of 2021. Share of revenue from equipment sales reached 22 per cent. Revenue from services provided to residential customers (B2C) amounted to 61 per cent, to business customers (B2B) – 37.9 per cent and others – 1.1 per cent of the total revenue.

Over the last twelve months, the number of converged service offer, Telia1, users in terms of households increased from 67 to 80 thousand. Telia1 gives more value – higher speed, more data and more TV content – to those who have both fixed and mobile services of Telia Lietuva.

During first three months of 2021 the number of post-paid **mobile** communication service users increased by 13 thousand, while the number of pre-paid service users went down by 26 thousand mainly due to seasonality. Over the last twelve months, the total number of active mobile subscriptions went up by 36 thousand. Higher number of customers, increasing usage of mobile data resulted in growth of revenue from billed mobile services.

Revenue from **other mobile services** for the first quarter of 2021 compared with the same period a year ago were lower mainly due to continuous restrictions on cross-border commuting, that were imposed in March of 2020, and impact network interconnection and roaming services.

During January-March of 2021, the number of fixed telephony lines in service eased by 8 thousand and over the last twelve months went down by 33 thousand. As a result revenue from retail **voice telephony** services over the year went down by 16.6 per cent and revenue from voice transit service for the first quarter of 2021 was 9 per cent lower than a year ago.

Over the last twelve months, the number of fixed **broadband Internet** access users over fiber-optic network using FTTH/B technologies increased by 9 thousand, while the number of broadband Internet service users over the copper DSL connections eased by 3 thousand. The total net increase in the number of broadband Internet access users was 6 thousand. By the end of March 2021, the number of Internet connections over the fiber-optic access network amounted to 72 per cent of all retail broadband Internet connections.

During January-March of 2021, the number of smart **television** (IPTV) service users remained unchanged, while over the last twelve months it increased by 7 thousand.

Revenue from **IT services** generated from the data center, information system management and web-hosting services showed a double-digit growth due to pandemic caused ongoing demand for virtual private network (VPN),



computerised workplace management and other IT solutions. Telia Lietuva was recognised as biggest Managed Services provider in the region by IBM.

Revenue from **other services** consists of the non-telecommunication services such as Directory Inquiry service 118 provided to external customers, lease of premises, discount refunds and other.

From 1 March 2021, the Company terminated provision of commercial information such as companies' contacts, transport timetables, business, leisure and other information by the Directory Inquiry service 118. Only obligatory information about publicly announced subscribers' phone numbers will be provided by the phone number 118.

COVID-19 pandemic caused remote working and learning, and partially closed retail outlets still has an impact on **equipment sale** pattern: demand for laptops and TV sets is still high, while sale of mobile devices is also recovering.

Gain or loss from sale of property, plant and equipment, as well as gain or loss on currency exchange is recorded at net value as **other gain (loss)**. In the beginning of 2021, the Company sold an office building in Kaunas and recorded EUR 1.2 million gain from sale of property.

MARKET INFORMATION

According to the latest Report of the Communications Regulatory Authority (CRA), the Lithuanian electronic communications market in terms of revenue for the year 2020 amounted to EUR 729.6 million, an increase by 2.2 per cent over the total market revenue of EUR 713.7 million for January-December of 2019, mainly due to growth in mobile and fixed Internet access as well as pay TV segments.

Telia Lietuva remains the largest telecommunications' service provider in Lithuania with the market share (in term of revenue) of 38.2 per cent in the fourth quarter of 2020 with leaders' position on fixed broadband Internet, pay TV and fixed voice telephony markets, while on mobile voice and mobile Internet markets the Company is the third.

According to the Report, on 31 December 2020, broadband Internet penetration per 100 residents of Lithuania was 53.6 per cent (50.9 per cent a year ago) and pay-TV penetration per 100 households was 50.2 per cent (51.7 per cent a year ago). The penetration of active mobile voice communication users per 100 residents was 131.4 per cent (132.6 per cent a year ago) and penetration of fixed voice telephony lines per 100 households – 22.6 per cent (26.8 per cent a year ago).

Cost of goods and services went up mainly due to higher equipment sale. Employee related expenses in spite of reduced number of employees were higher than in 2020 due to increased employees' salaries and higher accruals for vacations. Other expenses were higher mainly due to higher price for electricity. Non-recurring expenses in both 2021 and 2020 were related to one-off redundancy pay-outs.

On 1 July 2020, the Company's subsidiary Telia Customer Service LT, AB was merged into the Company and all **employees** of merged subsidiary became employees of Telia Lietuva, AB. In August 2020, 69 employees involved in maintenance of copper access network were outsourced to the third party.

Non-recurring items for the first quarter of 2021 were comprised from one-off redundancy pay-outs of EUR 347 thousand and gain of EUR 1.2 million from sale of office building in Kaunas. In January-March of 2020, there were only non-recurring expenses – one-off redundancy pay-outs of EUR 234 thousand.

Loss from investments during the first quarter of 2020 represent result from activities of associated entity UAB Mobilieji Mokėjimai that on 18 June 2020 was disposed. In March 2020, shareholders of Mobilieji Mokėjimai – three Lithuanian mobile operators: Bitė Lietuva, Tele2 and Telia Lietuva – decided to cease operations of this loss generating associate from 18 May 2020. As of 31 December 2019, the value of this investment was impaired to one euro. During the first quarter of 2020, the Company extended loan for the total amount of EUR 202 thousand to Mobilieji Mokėjimai at an annual interest rate of 3.37 per cent.

The profit tax rate in Lithuania is 15 per cent. Following the provisions of the Law on Corporate Profit Tax regarding tax relief for investments in new technologies, the profit tax relief during January-March of 2021 amounted to EUR 0.5 million (EUR 0.1 million in 2020).



FINANCIAL POSITION AND CASH FLOW

During the last twelve months **total assets** grew mainly due to increase in cash and cash equivalents. As of 31 March 2021, the total non-current assets amounted to 73.6 per cent (75.2 per cent a year ago), the total current assets – to 26.2 per cent (24.6 per cent), whereof cash alone represented 12.6 per cent (9.1 per cent) of total assets. Over the year **shareholders' equity** increased due to higher net profit for the first quarter of 2021 and at the end of March 2021 amounted to 55.8 per cent of the total assets (56.1 per cent a year ago).

The Board of the Company proposed to the General Meeting to be held on 27 April 2021 to allocate from the Company's distributable profit of EUR 145.7 million an amount of EUR 58.3 million for the payment of **dividends** for the year 2020, i.e. EUR 0.10 dividend per share, and carry forward to the next financial year an amount of EUR 87.4 million as retained earnings (undistributed profit).

Dividends paid to legal entities (residents and non-residents) will be subject to withholding Corporate income tax of 15 per cent and dividends paid to natural persons (residents and non-residents) will be subject to withholding Personal income tax of 15 per cent.

On 4 January 2021, the Company repaid the last instalment (EUR 7.5 million) and completed repayment of EUR 150 million loan that was borrowed in January 2016 to finance acquisition of Omnitel shares.

The Company has a valid till May 2021 Revolver Loan Agreement with the largest shareholder of the Company, Telia Company AB, that provides the Company with possibility to borrow any amount for a tenor of 3- or 6- months up to the total amount of EUR 20 million. As of 31 March 2021, the Company had no borrowings from Telia Company.

During the first quarter of 2021, the total **capital investments** were 17.8 per cent higher than capital expenditure of a year ago. An amount of EUR 2.6 million was invested into development of IT systems under ongoing business management systems transformation program.

The Company has started a major upgrade of its **radio access network (RAN)** with Ericsson equipment thus phasing out equipment from Huawei earlier used in Telia Lietuva mobile network. Over the next three years, the Company plans to upgrade around 2,000 sites in Lithuania. This will further improve the quality of 4G networks and ensure a fast upgrade to 5G, which will eventually be available throughout the country. Currently, Telia Lietuva provides non-commercial 5G connectivity in the city centers of Vilnius, Kaunas and Klaipėda. The commercial roll-out of 5G mobile communication services in Lithuania is subject to 5G frequency auction, which is expected to take place in 2021.

According to the latest Communication Regulatory Authorities measurement data, the average mobile Internet speed in Telia Lietuva 4G network remains the highest in the country amounting to 93.5 Mbps.

The Company invested EUR 2 million into expansion and modernization of its S2 **data centre** in Parko str., Vilnius. The upgraded Tier III-compliant data centre features the highest level of reliability and highly efficient technology. This data centre is equipped with 80 server stands with a total capacity of 400 kW. Just like other Telia Lietuva data centres, it uses 100 per cent green electricity. It also has energy-efficient modern cooling equipment. The services provided in the Company's data centers comply with the key IT service management and security standards ISO 27001 and ISO 20000, and the availability of services is as high as 99.985 per cent.

By the end of March 2021, the Company had 939 thousand households passed (932 thousand a year ago), or 70 per cent of the country's dwelling units, by the fiber-optic network.

SHARE CAPITAL AND SHAREHOLDERS

The **authorised capital** of the Company amounts to 168,957,810.02 euro and consists of 582,613,138 ordinary registered shares with a nominal value of 0.29 euro each. The number of the Company's shares that provide voting rights during the General Meeting is 582,613,138.

582,613,138 ordinary registered shares of Telia Lietuva, AB (ISIN code LT0000123911) are listed on the Main List of Nasdaq Vilnius stock exchange (code: TEL1L). Nasdaq Vilnius stock exchange is a home market for the Company's shares.

From January 2011, the Company's shares are included into the trading lists of Berlin Stock Exchange (Berlin Open Market (Freiverkehr), Frankfurt Stock Exchange (Open Market (Freiverkehr), Munich Stock Exchange and Stuttgart Stock Exchange. Telia Lietuva share's symbol on German stock exchanges is ZWS.

5 Provisions (continued)

The restructuring provision comprises of compensation to employees due to the restructuring plan (if any) approved by the Company. No restructuring provisions in 2021.

The Company leases land for the construction of mobile stations. Upon expiry of the lease term the mobile stations should be disassembled, and land restored so that it could be returned to the land owner in a condition it was before the lease. Similarly, the Company has telecommunication equipment installed in the premises or on the buildings leased from third parties. This equipment will have to be disassembled when the lease agreement expires. To cover these estimated future costs, assets retirement obligation has been recognised. The Company expects that assets retirement obligation will be realised later than after one year. Therefore, the whole amount of assets retirement obligation has been classified as non-current provision for other liabilities and charges.

6 Income tax

The tax expenses for the period comprise current and deferred tax.

Profit for 2021 is taxable at a rate of 15 per cent in accordance with Lithuanian regulatory legislation on taxation (2020: 15 per cent).

According to the Law on Corporate Profit Tax which provides tax relief for investments in new technologies, the Company's calculated profit tax relief in 2021 amounted to EUR 0.5 million (in 2020 – EUR 0.1 million).

7 Earnings per share

Basic earnings per share are calculated by dividing the net profit (loss) for the period by the weighted average number of ordinary shares in issue during the period. The Group has no dilutive potential ordinary shares and therefore diluted earnings per share are the same as basic earnings per share. The weighted average number of shares for the both reporting periods amounted to 582,613 thousand.
