Share Buyback Program

On [26 February 2026](#), Bekaert announced the start of the next tranche of its share buyback program, for a total maximum consideration of up to € 75 million. As announced previously, the purpose of the Program is to cancel all shares repurchased.

Bekaert announces today that during the period from 30 July 2026 to 5 August 2026, Kepler Cheuvreux SA on behalf of Bekaert has bought 50 500 shares.
